David Booth - Director of Player Personnel, New Orleans Pelicans

David Booth begins his eighth season with the New Orleans Pelicans, his fifth as director of player personnel after serving as director of scouting in 2012-13 and regional scout from 2010-12.

Booth came to New Orleans from his alma mater, DePaul University, where he served as an assistant coach during the 2009-10 season. He received his first NBA experience as a regional scout with the Memphis Grizzlies from 2005-09 after a one-year stint as an assistant coach at Illinois Central Community College.

Prior to playing 13 years of professional basketball, Booth was a four-year letterman at DePaul from 1988-92, where he ranks among the program's top 10 in scoring, field goals, steals, free throws and blocked shots. He ranks second in school history with 1,933 career points and third all-time with 713 career field goals. Booth received a degree in communications from DePaul University in 1992. He and his wife, Melissa, have three children, Mariah, 26, Sydney, 22, and Brandon, 18.
