Daniel Nwaelele Jr. went to Inglemoor High school in Kenmore, WA. Following his high school graduation he attended the Air Force Prep School and the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs from 2002 – 2007. graduating high school, I attended the Air Force Prep School and the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs from 2002-2007.

After graduating from high school, Nwaelele joined the Air Force Falcons. In four seasons, he averaged 9.8 points, 2.4 rebounds and 1.6 assists per game. At the end of his stay at the Academy, he was ranked second in program history in three-point field goal percentage with 45.1 percent. During his career with the Falcons, they were Mountain West Conference Champions in 2003, made two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2004 and 2006 and played in the NIT Final Four in 2007.

Following his collegiate career Nwaelele was stationed at Keesler Air Force Base Biloxi, MS as a Contracting Officer for 5 year Active Duty Service Commitment (2007-2012). In 2010 he was deployed to Kandahar, Afghanistan, and to Riyadh, Saudi Arabia in 2011.
