Biographical Information

Mike Wilks graduated from Rufus King High School in Milwaukee, and played his collegiate basketball at Rice University where he earned Western Athletic Conference Scholar Athlete honors.

Wilks began his professional career as an undrafted free agent in 2002 and throughout his career has played for various teams including the San Antonio Spurs (with whom he won a title in 2005), closing out his career with the Oklahoma City Thunder.

In October 2012, Wilks joined the Oklahoma City Thunder as a scout and currently serves as their pro scout.

Wilks wore number 29 throughout his NBA career (with the exception of his stint with the Spurs, in which he wore 11), as a tribute to Milwaukee's 29th Street playground where he grew up playing the game.
