



Apostle Terry Cummings

Biographical Information

Robert Terrell "Terry" Cummings went to Carver High School in Chicago, and was an All-American at DePaul University.

Terry entered the 1982 NBA draft, the second overall selection and selected in the first round by the San Diego Clippers. In 1983, his inaugural season he won the NBA Rookie of the year award after putting up 23.7 points and 10.4 rebounds per game. He was an All-Star Game participant in 1985 and 1989

In 18 seasons Terry Cummings scored 19,460 points, falling just short of the 20,000 point mark, but placing him among the top 50 career scorers.

A Pentecostal Minister since the age of 16, Cummings also writes his own songs and began releasing CDs in 2005.
